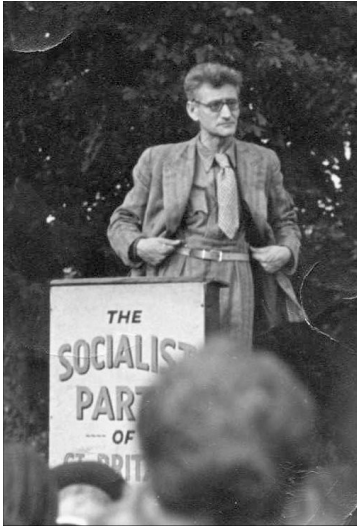


The Rotary Club of Plymouth – Foothills

Speaker Guidelines



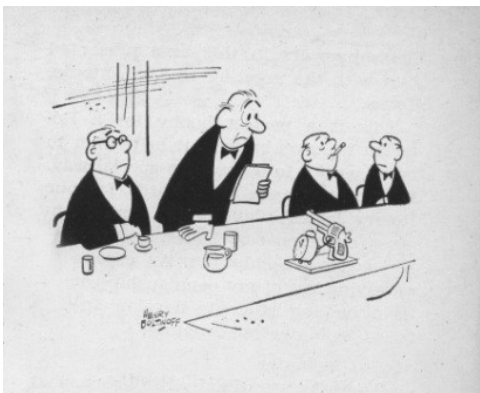
Thank you for accepting our invitation to speak to our club! High quality programs are important to us because they make attendance worthwhile. When you speak to our members, you are rewarding them for the good works they do in the community.

A good program can be just about anything – so long as it is executed well. One of the best speakers I know speaks about mudslides (Scott Burns, Professor of Geology, Portland State University) and his audiences love him! So, show up with an interesting topic and enthusiasm and you can't go wrong.

Our Club does not want programs where the speaker is directly asking our members for money or time for the speaker's causes, however you're encouraged to bring handouts/brochures describing your product or service. We allow programs about politics and about religion, but we do not allow political or religious programs. **Bottom line – no pitches.** However, we would love to hear what makes your organization unique, interesting and effective, etc.

One of our members will be designated as the “**Chair of the Day**” and they are responsible for introducing you. You also need to **email us a topic description (a paragraph or two), a short speaker biography and one or more photos.** This is the information we use to build a crowd. Send this information to Program Committee Chairperson, Rick Sanders at rsanders@integritydm.com a month or more in advance, so your program can be announced in a way that it draws members and guests to that presentation.

We meet at 7:15 AM, at the 49'er Village, 18265 Highway 49, Plymouth, CA (directly across from the Pokerville Market), every Tuesday morning. You receive a free breakfast and a chance to meet with 20+ community leaders from our side of the county. Usually the speaker is on from about 7:55 AM to about 8:25 AM, **including** any question and answer period. After your presentation, the President will say a few words, hold a quick raffle and then adjourn at 8:30 AM sharp.
