We serve Plymouth, the Shenandoah Valley, River Pines, Fiddletown, Drytown, Amador City and the surrounding foothill area. We work with local schools, communities and other groups to provide assistance where ever possible.

Our local projects have included working with City of Plymouth to sponsor the annual Plymouth Flea Market, and the late-summer Plymouth Community Market. We work with Plymouth Elementary School where we provide a personal dictionary to every 3rd grader. We also work with the school to assist the 6th graders with their wall mural or science camp. Other projects include working the annual child safety day. We work with other organizations to collect funds for the “A Christmas to Remember” program, where all of the donations are used to supply underprivileged children with one complete set of new clothing, from the ground up. On our Rotarians at Work Day, we pick a project somewhere in the area that needs “hands-on” attention. This last year we repaired and painted the baseball dugouts in Plymouth.

Internationally, we participate in a program to send recently replace textbooks to the school children in the Fiji Islands. Another of our international projects is helping a struggling school in Zihuateneo, Mexico.

While the above sounds like a lot of work, it is also quite rewarding. Part of our goal is to have fun, and along the way we do manage that and we also develop lasting friendships.
